Art lovers, collectors, and members of the public are welcomed into the private working spaces of the diverse members of the Peekskill arts community. See works in progress and talk to individual artists about their creative inspirations and methods.

Open Studios visitors can pick up a complimentary catalog containing information on participating artists and a map highlighting all the must-see elements of Open Studios at the Gazebo on North Division Street. Online versions of the catalog and map will also be available on our website so you can easily travel throughout Peekskill using your smartphone.

Visit artists' studios throughout downtown Peekskill including the new Art Lofts on Main Street and those on South and Central Avenue. Check out exhibits at Westchester Community College's "Off the Beaten Track" for artists without studios in the Downtown Artist District and visit the many artists at the pop-up Truck Stop Gallery (Saturday only) at Central Avenue and check out the Artisans Boutique at Studio 4 on 925 South Street and the gallery at the Peekskill Clay Studios in the Hat Factory further out of town on N. Division Street.

Visit the Field Gallery and The Hudson Valley MOCA (HVMOCA). HV MOCA will be offering free admission for the weekend and a get-together Saturday night.
